The instructors will cover all 100 examination topics and the renewed question bank from which examination questions are drawn.

Students will be given internet access to the online course at www.hamstudy.com. Hamstudy has all the questions from the recently modified question bank and includes the theory required to answer those questions.

For students who want to also have a printed study guide, the new Hamstudy Basic manual is expected to be released very soon. Older versions of the Hamstudy or other Canadian manuals continue to be a good reference. Hamstudy Basic is sold by Radio Amateurs of Canada at www.amazon.ca.

There will be 1 hour lunch breaks. We encourage bringing your lunches with you as there are no nearby food services.

The formal examination is included in this course and will be conducted in the afternoon of Nov 23rd. Photo identification (Driver licence) is required.
